

Welcome to the Webster Arts Fair 2020. We look forward to seeing you June 5-7 in Webster Groves, Missouri!

Coordinating a fair of 105 artists and 20,000 guests takes a year of planning, 250 volunteers and a few rules to make things run smoothly. We are committed to create an atmosphere where you can present original fine art for our patrons to collect.

We promise to provide you with the best hospitality we can offer, unlimited cold water in your own reusable bottle, dinner Friday and Saturday nights, breakfast Saturday and Sunday mornings, snacks all day, a real bathroom for your use, and friendly volunteers to help meet your needs.

In exchange, here is what we ask of you:

- Artist must be present during all fair hours. Representatives, spouses or children may not attend in the artist's place for longer than short breaks. Please bring a state ID at check in.
- All work must be the original work of the accepted artist, made by hand. No artwork from molds, kits or other commercial methods is allowed. No production work.
 Collaborative Partners are artists who participate materially in the creation of the art.
- Artists may exhibit artwork only in the category in which accepted. Artists must display an accurate artist statement detailing methods or techniques.
- Copies from the works of masters, advertisements and widely circulated photographs are not considered original works of art and will not be permitted.
- Art exhibited and booth set up must accurately reflect the work that was submitted for jurying. The Executive Director reserves the right to ask that any work that is inconsistent with the juried subject be removed.
- Plagiarism, production line art or factory-reproduced items are grounds for immediate removal from the show.
- Signed reproductions may be sold, but will be displayed in portfolios and bins, (not on panels or screens) and clearly labeled as reproductions. Work on screens or panels must be in frames or professionally presented. Limit reproductions to 10% of your work, please.
- Reproductions on canvas are not allowed. Photography on canvas is not allowed unless printed in the artists' studio by the artist. Photography on canvas must be approved in advance by the show director.
- Photography & works on paper produced through retail labs are not permitted. All
 artists are required to disclose both their creative and printing processes on any prints,
 which have been properly signed. Numbered editions in fewer than 50 are
 encouraged. Prints on canvas are not permitted.

- Commercially-produced items bearing your art ARE NOT PERMITTED at the Webster
 Arts Fair. Examples include coasters, cutting boards, mouse pads, drinking glasses or
 mugs, books, etc. If you have questions, please call the director for clarification. Labproduced note cards are permitted in limited amounts if the images reflect the
 photography, painting, drawing, etc., that was juried. One card stand is permitted
 within the confines of the booth and must be shown in the booth image. Webster Arts
 reserves the right to consult with the artist on fixtures in the booth before invitation
 acceptance. Reproductions of paintings or photographs on canvas are not permitted.
- Photographers may show original work printed on metal but no more than 10% of work.
- **Display of art may not extend beyond the confines of the booth.** No bins or tables in the aisles, please. Artists' chairs in the aisles that restrict traffic flow will be relocated.
- No signage or banners that extent beyond the tent.
- White tents ONLY. All tents must be properly staked or weighted.
- Electric is provided to all artists at no additional charge. Please limit your electrical consumption to the minimum you need to operate your lights when necessary. A small personal fan is permitted. Please, no generators, air conditioners or refrigerators.
- All artists MUST bring outdoor rated extension cords. Indoor cords are not permitted and will be removed by staff. Indoor cords can short and crash the electrical grid. Please, be considerate. Bring ONLY OUTDOOR RATED cords.
- The Webster Arts Fair is a guest of Eden Theological Seminary. We ask your
 partnership in respecting the grounds, trees, plants and facilities. Please enter and exit
 the field with your vehicle only on the paths indicated and follow the instructions of
 volunteers.
